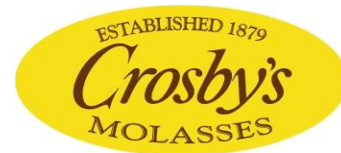

BLACKSTRAP MOLASSES – RETAIL

Description: Blackstrap molasses is the residual liquid food obtained in the manufacturing of raw sugar. The cane juice, after having been purified, is concentrated into a thick mass. At the end of the process the resulting molasses is very dark and has a robust, somewhat bitter-tart flavour.

Contains no added sulfates or sulfites.

General Uses:

The unique flavour of this molasses adds zest to a wide variety of cooking and baking projects.

Storage requirements:

10°C to 21°C (50°F to 70°F) under reasonably steady conditions of temperature & humidity.
